## Science in Reception

- I can talk about my immediate environment using knowledge from looking, talking, stories, books and maps.
- I can explore and create using a wide range of materials and equipment, including upcycled materials, construction kits, textiles and ingredients.
- I know different materials (for example, emtal, wood, plastic, fabric) have different properties (hard, soft, smooth, rough, waterproof) and can be used for different purposes.
- I can safely use and explore a variety of materials, tools and techniques when experimenting with colour, design, texture, form and function.
- I can sort and group materials and resources and talk about how they are similar or different (based on their size, shape, feel).
- I know what a human body normally has (a head, neck, body, two arms, two legs, two hands, two feet, five fingers and five toes).
- I know what a human face usually has (two eyes, a nose and a mouth).
- I can represent different parts of the human body from observation, imagination or memory and can include some of these details in my drawing.
- I can understand some important processes and changes in the natural world around me, (like the seasons and changing states of matter).
- I can explore the natural world around me, making observations and drawing pictures of animals and plants.
- I can develop my knowledge in Science through play activities, sharing stories and books and discussion.
