

## Art in Upper Key Stage 2

### Taotie

- I can explore and use different types of casting (paper, clay and silicone).
- I can design, make and evaluate my plaster cast (using the same techniques of Taotie).

### Nature's Art

- I can investigate and evaluate how natural resources are used in art (Cone (Goldsworthy), Spiral Jetty (Smithson), Sitka Sphere (Jae Hyo)).
- I can use my sketchbook to record my initial ideas and final designs (before making my own natural art installation).

### Mixed Media

- I can explore different uses of paper in art (decoupage, marbling, quilling and paper folding).
- I can describe what surrealism is and its impact within art.
- I can create my own photo in the style of a surreal collage (listening to feedback from others and evaluating my own practice).

### Bees, Beetles and Butterflies

- I can explore photography of insects and use these in my own initial designs (within my sketchbook).
- Explore the work of a contemporary artist (Lucy Arnold and Andy Warhol) and describe the reasons for their use of colour.

### Trailblazers

- I can tell you about black artists from the past and present (Edmonia Lewis (past), Augusta Savage (past), Elizabeth Catlett (past), Yinka Shonibare (present), Chris Ofili & Turgo Bastien, (present)).
- I can make replicas of famous artwork (choosing my own perspective of their work).

### Environmental Artists

- I can discuss how recycled, reused or repurposed materials can be used in art (describing famous artwork in the present day).
- I can state an environmental message about plastic (by designing, creating and evaluating my own art work installation).
