<u>Art in Key Stage 1</u>

Flower Heads

- I can explore colour and pattern (when making my own paper flower).
- I can explain the art of Yayoi Kusama.
- I can explain the differences and similarities of making flowers (when using either clay or paper).

Portraits and Poses

- I can explore the work of different paintings from different times of the monarchy (describing similarities and differences)
- I can use drawings to share my imagination and ideas (both pencil and computer based pictures).

<u>Still Life</u>

- I can discuss and evaluate art (when I visit an art gallery).
- I can find similarities and difference between two pieces of still life art, comparing themes, colours, composition, objects and texture.
- I can name some famous still life artists (Paul Cézanne, Vincent van Gogh, Cornelis Gijsbrechts, Roy Lichtenstein and Georges Braque.)

<u>Mix it</u>

- I can explore and experiment with mixing colours (both primary and secondary colours).
- I can examine and perform printing with different colours (block printing).

Funny Faces

- I can understand what a collage is and make one (of a funny face).
- I can join paper effectively (using a simple running stitch).
- I can evaluate my own work and that of others (offering suggestions).
